

Clemson University Student Alumni Association Constitution

Article I

Name

Section 1. The name of this organization shall be the Clemson University Student Alumni Association. The organization shall popularly be referred to hereafter as SAA.

Article II

Affiliation

Section 1. SAA shall be affiliated with and responsible to the Clemson University Alumni Association. SAA shall be operated in accordance with the constitution of the Clemson University Alumni Association and state and federal laws governing the CUAA.

Article III

Purpose

Section 1. We, the members of SAA, shall try to develop a means of interaction among students, alumni, faculty and the community; gain an understanding and appreciation of alumni activities and programs, and convey this to the rest of the student body; establish, maintain and promote the traditions of Clemson University; serve as a public relations vehicle for Clemson University and the Clemson Alumni Association; establish our identity as a viable organization through special events, community service projects, and social activities; and create an atmosphere in which lasting friendships may be developed.

Objectives:

1. Increase Alumni Association's visibility among current students, its future alumni.
2. Provide benefits that will create student awareness of the Alumni Association as an organization that can positively impact the student experience.
3. Lay the foundation for future involvement in the Alumni Association and the Clemson Fund.

Article IV

Membership

Section 1. All students enrolled in Clemson University, undergraduate and graduate, are eligible for SAA membership. In order to be considered for membership, certain criteria must be met as outlined by the By-Laws. SAA will not discriminate on the basis of race,
